IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE CORNISH TOWN DRINKING WATER SYSTEM has a Not Approved rating with the State of Utah Division of Drinking Water.

Our water system is generally in non-compliance due to physical deficiencies and/or violations resulting in a Not Approved rating with the Utah Division of Drinking Water. The Utah Division of Drinking Water maintains ratings for all public water systems. An Approved rating shows that a public water system is generally in compliance with all rules and regulations to maintain safe drinking water. A Not Approved rating shows a water system is generally in non-compliance through physical facility deficiencies or violations.

Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know the rating of your public water system, and what we are doing to correct this situation. The following table shows the specific issues within our system:

Deficiency/Violation	Date of Occurrence	Plan to return to compliance	Severity (deficiencies: significant, minor, recommended, violations: major, minor)
TD13-Chlorine vent line not discharged above grade or lacks a No. 14 screen	06/24/2006	Ensure that vent line is discharged above grade and has a No. 14 screen	Minor
Storage tank roof or sidewalls show signs of mild or moderate deterioration	09/08/2020	Repair tank roof and sidewalls	Minor
Cross Connection Cert. lacks written records of CCC activities	07/06/2017	Complete CCC activities and submit written records	Minor

What should I do?

You do not need to use an alternative (e.g., bottled) water supply. However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

What does this mean?

This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately.

What happened? What is being done?

We anticipate resolving the Pitcher Well problem next year spring and have obtained an engineer study. The Pitcher well is anticipated to be worked on later in the year.
