

FIRST CDBG PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
Cornish Town CDBG PUBLIC HEARING
HEARING HELD (4788 W. 14300 N. Cornish, Utah, December 15, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.)

The Cornish Town Council first CDBG public hearing was held on Wednesday, December 15, 2021, in the Cornish Town Hall at 4788 W. 14300 N, Cornish, Utah, meeting commenced at 7:08 p.m.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Leak opened the public hearing for the CDBG program and stated that the purpose for the public hearing is to provide citizens with pertinent information about the Community Development Block Grant program and to allow for discussion of possible applications for the 2022 funding cycle. It was explained that the grant money must be spent on projects benefiting primarily low and moderate-income persons. Mayor Leak also explained that the Bear River AOG in which Cornish Town is a member, is expecting to receive approximately \$799,991 in the new program year. All eligible activities that can be accomplished under this program are identified in the CDBG Application Policies and Procedures Manual and interested persons can review it at any time.

Mayor Leak read several of the eligible activities listed including examples such as construction of public works and facilities, e.g., water and sewer lines, fire stations, acquisition of real property, provision of public services such as food banks or homeless shelters. Mayor Leak indicated that Cornish Town had applied for the CDBG grant in the past, but had not been awarded the grant. Mayor Leak then asked anyone with questions, comments or suggestions during the hearing to please identify themselves by name before they speak so the clerk can include their names in the minutes. Mayor Leak stated that the council would like to specifically respond to any question and suggestions during the hearing.

Colton Creech asked what the dollar amount was again that the mayor had mentioned that the Bear River AOG was expecting to receive. Mayor Leak stated \$799,991. Creech asked if that was the amount that Cornish Town could be awarded if they were approved for the grant. Mayor Leak stated that this is the total amount expected for the Bear River District and Cornish Town would only be able to qualify for a portion of that amount of money if awarded the grant. Mayor Leak asked if there were any other questions or suggestions. There were none. The hearing was adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
